THE LEGAL FLAW IN THE DEFINITION:

The term "fluoride" does not specify the legal classification of fluorides used for fluoridation and whether this classification allows this fluoride compound to be used in a therapeutic role to prevent dental caries and to associate a therapeutic claim with it.

DEFINITIONS

2. The definitions that apply to the Food and Drug Act

“drug” includes any substance or mixture of substances manufactured, sold or represented for use in

(a) the diagnosis, treatment, mitigation or prevention of a disease, disorder or abnormal physical state, or its symptoms, in human beings or animals,

(b) restoring, correcting or modifying organic functions in human beings or animals, or

Official Definition:

Fluorides are added to drinking water so that it contains the ideal amount to prevent tooth decay:

- *a therapeutic role,*
- *a therapeutic objective,*
- *with a therapeutic attribution.*

Food and Drug Act

According to legal definitions, only substances classified as

"drugs" or

"natural health products"

may have a therapeutic role and may be attributed a therapeutic claim..

Health Canada's response to environmental
petition number 299, pursuant to section 22 of the
Auditor General Act:

Health Canada

- does not approve,
- does not regulate,
- does not test,
- does not monitor the sanitary state
of fluoridation chemicals.

WHAT HEALTH CANADA DOES NOT DO:

Health Canada does not approve fluoridation chemicals in any of the five categories under its jurisdiction:

1. Drugs

2. Natural health products

3. Nutrients for food fortification

4. Foods

5. Food additives

According to Health Canada, fluoridation products are
“water treatment chemicals”
and fall under provincial jurisdiction.

Consequently, legally they are not:

-  **- drugs**
-  **- natural health products**
-  **- sources of a nutrient for food fortification**
-  **- food**
-  **- food additives**

Therefore, Health Canada has not proven that fluoridation chemicals are:

- **EFFECTIVE** in preventing tooth decay
- **SAFE**, meaning no harmful effects
- **SANITARY**, meaning they are manufactured, packaged, transported and stored under sanitary conditions, because their industrial manufacture is not subject to any government oversight.

An unauthorized drug not regulated by Health Canada is an:

illegal drug.

Fluoridation chemicals are as illegal drugs than street fentanyl!!!!
